Notice of Public Hearing **REVISED 9/7/10**

As a condition of compliance with *Education Code* Section 60119 and *California Code of Regulations, Title 5*, Section 9531(c), district, charter school and county office of education local governing boards are required to hold an annual public hearing and adopt a resolution stating whether each pupil in the district or charter school has, or will have prior to the end of that year, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials in each subject consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education. Sufficient textbooks or instructional materials means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home in the six subject areas of mathematics, science, history-social science and English-language arts, health, and foreign language and have sufficient science laboratory materials.

Furthermore, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the same four subject areas.

Therefore, a public hearing regarding instructional materials sufficiency will be held September 16, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Fresno County Board of Education. The location of the meeting will be:
